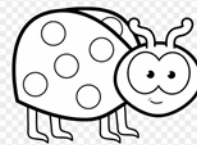

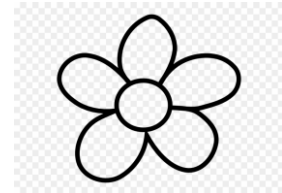

- **English –**

A warm welcome to our Thornlands State School families, new and old.

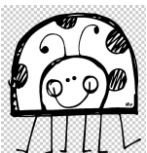
