Update on the year so far....

The year has been progressing well for the school and the P&C, with a number of key fundraising activities held, the tuckshop and uniform shop continuing to support families and the hall has been well used through hirers from the school and community groups.

To date, the P&C has been able to attract a grant from Councillor Paul Golle for \$2150, which helped to purchase a shipping container near the hall so that stock, administration rec-

ords, the BBQ and other equipment can be stored out of the way of other school storage needs.

Based on strategic planning and consultation earlier in the year to renew our goals after air-conditioning the school, the key focus for the P&C is to upgrade all of the playground areas. This will end up costing at least \$130,000 to do all of them, so these will be staged. This will help in reaching funding targets as well as aiming to seek additional

support through community grants.

The first area that is in focus is to sort out the sandpit for years PYA/PYB and then redesign of the area between Grade 1 block and the hall so that the runoff won't happen if there is heavy rain. This has been estimated to cost approximately \$40,000 to put in place but is essential before other upgrades are made in that area so that the infrastructure will last. We will keep you up to date as we start getting closer to achieving this goal and work commences.

Fundraising progress

There have been a number of really successful fundraising events held during the year so far.

The school discos in Term 1 and just recently in Term 3 have helped generate over \$7000 for the P&C.

The School Fun Run was also well received, and provided an additional \$5000 from generous families and friends.

The School Fun Run donations race was very competitive, and there were a number of winners across the classes and students.

The tuckshop was also amazing in supporting the meal deal in Term 2, with both the tuckshop staff and volunteers helping to provide hundreds of meal deals for the hungry masses. Special thanks to our tuckshop team, Robyn and Kelly and also to Erin for the flyer, and Karen, Courtney, Briony, Kelli and Selena, who were willing to help out on the day.

We will look to holding another disco in Term 4 on October 31—of course, with a Halloween theme, and a meal deal as well before the end of the year.

Future events that will be coming up include the Father's Day stall and raffles for the Christmas Concert. If you own a business that is happy to donate to the Christmas Concert raffle then please let us know as we are getting ready to be able to sell tickets early in Term 4.

If you would like to help with fundraising over the next few months, we would love to hear from you, and also if you are just happy to help on event days or when you have time to serve drinks, be a disco queen or be a friendly face to greet parents.
